Along with a generous fostering allowance, we award two bonus payments of £250 each year in the summer and winter, along with an appreciation bonus of up to £1,000 depending on length of service with us. Not just that, but you'll also receive gifts for each milestone you hit, along with our annual appreciation day with events and days out local to you.

We also provide all our foster parents with access to our rewards platform where you can take advantage of fantastic discounts across hundreds of high street names, online stores and supermarkets.

- A referrals teams that concentrate on making quality matches
- Therapists who work with foster parents and staff so that we help our foster parents care therapeutically
- Dedicated out of hours staff that know how to support you if something goes wrong

All our foster parents complete a detailed preparation programme that will equip you with all the skills and knowledge you need to be a successful foster parent. Expert Matching

Our dedicated referrals team work alongside 10 local authorities throughout the region to offer a wide range of fostering opportunities. We have an excellent track record for quality matching, ensuring your family and the child who will be in your care have a successful and happy fostering experience together. 70% of our children are placed in long-term care with our foster families.

Diverse Fostering Opportunities

We work with all the local authorities to offer a wide range of fostering opportunities. We have single foster parents who care for children on a short-term placement, foster parents who care for a parent and child, and retired couples supporting teenagers to independence. We recognise the diversity of our families and offer support to all members of the fostering household and support network. This could be birth children, grandparents, friends or extended family.



Support Group Meetings

You'll be invited to monthly local support groups held throughout the region to help you build and maintain friendships with other foster parents and access a wider support network. These groups can offer specific support and guidance for foster parents and help you access support tailored to your family circumstances.

Experienced Foster Parents Providing Specialist Care

Our foster parents come from all backgrounds and are of all ages. Between them, they have approximately over 518 years of combined experience.

We have specialised foster parents for children and young people with disabilities, unaccompanied minors, and Parent and Child placements. Together, they offer a wealth of knowledge to both new and experienced foster parents.

Training and Development

Children and young people in our region share their experiences directly with potential foster parents during the pre-approval Prepare to Foster training. Additionally, birth children from fostering families also speak to prospective foster parents, offering valuable insights into the fostering journey.

Free Events and Activities

Your entire family is welcome to join us for our regular, free, fun events and days out throughout the year. We also acknowledge and celebrate all the achievements of our children and young people in true big FCA style!

Our supervising social workers and participation officer work with all our young people aged 14 years plus to give them the essential skills for independence.
