Along with a generous fostering allowance, we award two bonus payments of £250 each year in the summer and winter, along with an appreciation bonus of up to £1,000 depending on length of service with us. We also provide all our foster parents with access to our rewards platform where you can take advantage of fantastic discounts across hundreds of high street names, online stores and supermarkets.



Carer Buddy

We will allocate you a foster parent buddy so you and your family will benefit from support and guidance from someone who's already been in your shoes. Their own first-hand experience of the fostering journey means they can provide empathic, insightful advice to guide you through the process smoothly.





Therapeutic Care

We understand the importance of your development as a foster parent, as it enables you to provide the children you look after with the best trauma-informed care possible.

That's why, at FCA North West, we offer all foster parents therapeutic-based training. All our social workers take a therapeutic approach, and both staff and our foster parents receive training in Trauma and Attachment, as well as the PACE model of care.

We have a Principal Therapist who is on hand to offer advice, guidance, and resources, helping foster parents respond to a child's needs with empathy and sensitivity so they can provide the best levels of care. This includes:

- Our agency intranet therapy pages are available for everyone 24/7
- Foster parents have regular access to a range of trauma related learning resources
- As a staff group, we ensure that we are appropriately qualified, registered with professional bodies, and keep on top of our mandatory training and CPD
- A regularly updated online therapy library for staff to share with their foster parents

Support Group Meetings

You'll be invited to regular local support groups to help you build and maintain friendships with other foster parents and access a wider support network.

Expert Matching

We have an excellent track record for quality matching, carefully considering your experience and skills alongside the child or young person's needs. This ensures that your family and the child who will be in your care have a successful and happy fostering experience.

Participation

We have a strong focus on participation at FCA, where we actively engage with our children and young people. We always strive to improve by listening to our children and young people. Our innovative and proactive Participation Team ensures our children have their voices heard, gain new experiences, learn new skills, and have fun!

Education Support for Young People

FCA North West is a registered AQA Unit Award Scheme Centre. This means that children and young people of any age or ability can complete a range of AQA UAS Units and gain certificates, either through group workshops or independent achievements.

Some examples of topics young people can gain AQA certificates in include Diversity & Inclusion, Food Hygiene, Money & Budgeting, Volunteering, and Hair & Beauty. The AQA Award Scheme is a great way to support young people's confidence, selfesteem, and preparation for adulthood.

Partnering with universities and local providers, we also offer career and aspiration taster days. These days give young people the opportunity to experience what it's like to work in certain professions and gain an AQA certification to add to their CV for the future.
