Our very experienced local team provide 24/7 support 365 days a year.

Experienced Foster Parents Providing Specialist Care

Our foster parents come from all backgrounds and are of all ages. Between them, they have over 568 years of combined experience. We have several dedicated and committed foster parents who have over 20 years of experience, and our longest serving foster parent has been with the region for over 25 years.

We have specialised foster parents caring for children and young people with disabilities, unaccompanied minors, and Parent and Child, and teenagers. Together, they offer a wealth of knowledge to both new and existing foster parents.

Expert Matching and Placement Stability

Our dedicated referrals team work alongside 28 Local Authorities throughout the region to offer a wide range of fostering opportunities, such as Parent and Child fostering, long-term placements, and fostering unaccompanied asylum-seeking children. We have an excellent track record for quality matching, ensuring your family and the child who will be in your care have a successful and happy fostering experience together.

Our services are in demand in the South East, with regular referrals from the local authorities. This means once you're approved to foster with us, you won't have to wait long until you're matched with the right child for your family.

Support Group Meetings

You'll be invited to regular local support groups to help you build and maintain friendships with other foster parents and access a wider support network. This includes a strong Parent and Child group to help you access support tailored to your family's fostering circumstances.

Personal Development

For all our children and young people, we create a Personal Development Plan alongside a Learning & Development Strategy to ensure the individual needs of young people are met.

Empowering Young Voices: The Care Experienced Consultant Role

Following a national consultation with FCA's young people and those with care experience, we've introduced the **Care Experienced Consultant** role.

This role provides young people with care experience the opportunity to be employed on an 'as & when' basis within their local Participation Team. They assist with a range of activities, including consultations, providing feedback on procedures, supporting foster parent recruitment and training, and engaging in various activities.

Currently, we have one Care Experienced Consultant in our regional team. Since joining in January 2021, he has contributed to our **Prepare to Foster** training by sharing videos about his own time in care to offer valuable insights to our foster parents. He has also consulted with other children and young people to help us shape the service we provide for them.
