Therapeutic Care

We understand that your development as a foster parent is crucially important so that you can offer the children you look after the best trauma-informed care possible. That's why at FCA South Western we offer all our foster parents therapeutic-based training. Incorporating Adapt, Attune and PACE models of care, our training provides foster parents with the tools they need to build strong relationships with their foster children and help them to move through the trauma they have experienced.

We are supported by a team of therapists who are on hand to offer advice and guidance to help you respond to a child's needs with empathy and sensitivity to provide the best levels of care.

Social Worker Support

You'll develop a strong working relationship with your allocated supervising social worker, who'll provide weekly support calls, conduct monthly one-to-one supervision meetings, and help you access relevant training.

Support Group Meetings

You'll be invited to monthly local support groups held throughout the region to help you build and maintain friendships with other foster parents and access a wider support network. These groups can offer specific support and guidance for foster parents and help you access support tailored to your family circumstances.

Expert Matching

We have an excellent track record for quality matching, ensuring your family and the child in your care will have a successful and happy fostering experience together, giving careful thought to your experience and skills and what the child or young person needs.



Participation

We have a strong focus on participation at FCA South Western, where we actively engage our children and young people. Listening to our children and young people is how we strive to always improve. Our innovative and proactive Participation Team ensure that our children have their voices heard, gain new expereinces, learn new skills and have fun!

AQA Qualification Awards Scheme

FCA South Western is a registered AQA Unit Award Scheme Centre. This means that all our children and young people, of all ages and abilities, are encouraged to take part in a range of AQA UAS units which will enable them to gain recognised certificates from AQA. These units can be achieved either through group workshops or independent achievements.

Some examples of topics young people can gain AQA certificates in are Diversity and Inclusion, Food Hygiene, Money and Budgeting, Volunteering, and Hair and Beauty. AQA training is a great way to support young people's confidence, self-esteem and to prepare them for adulthood.

The Wave Project

At FCA South Western, we believe our children are our greatest achievement. Through partnerships like the Wave Project, we offer innovative wellbeing pathways that support resilience, self-esteem, and lifelong positive outcomes.
