Therapeutic Care

We understand that your development as a foster parent is crucially important so that you can offer the children you look after the best trauma-informed care possible. That's why at FCA Western we offer all of our foster parents therapeutic-based training. Incorporating Adapt, Attune and PACE models of care, our training provides foster parents with the tools they need to build strong relationships with their foster children and help them to move through the trauma they have experienced.

We are supported by a team of therapists who are on hand to offer advice and guidance to help you respond to a child's needs with empathy and sensitivity to provide the best levels of care.



Social Worker Support

You'll develop a deep working relationship with your dedicated supervising social worker, who'll support you by visiting regularly, conducting monthly one-to-one supervision meetings, and supporting you to access training.

Support Group Meetings

You'll be invited to regular local support groups to help you build and maintain friendships with other foster parents and access a wider support network. Our longstanding, experienced foster families offer peer support and guidance to newer families joining our team.
